- Remember to share all details of your child's medical history as it may impact your insurance benefits.
- Bring cash, a check, or an accepted credit card to your visits to pay for any applicable co-payments, deductibles, or non-covered services. We accept most major credit cards. *Newborn circumcisions must be paid by cash or credit cards only (no checks).*
- Understand that if we are not contracted with your insurance company, payment in full will be expected at the time of service.
- Let our staff assist you with the verification of benefits for surgical procedures, but know that this verification does not necessarily guarantee claim payment and, therefore, we may look to you for payment of any eligible charges denied by your insurance company.
